## **Pre-operative Instructions:**

- Nothing to eat or drink after midnight.
- o Discontinue NSAIDs (Aspirin, Motrin, Advil, Aleve) 1 week prior to surgery.
- o Obtain preoperative medical clearance from your PCP.
- Set up physical therapy appointment for 1-2 weeks post-op.
- Cold therapy is optional for arthroscopy and arthroplasty.

## **Post-operative Instructions:**

- Keep dressings/splint clean, dry, and intact until follow up appointment
- o Remove dressings and replace with Band-Aids in 3 days.
- OK to shower over incision in 3 days.
- No baths or spas for 2-3 weeks.

0	Non-weight bearing	0	Wear sling / splint at all times	0	Use crutches / boot at all times
0	Partial weight bearing	0	Wear sling / splint for comfort	0	Use crutches / boot only as needed
0	Weight bearing as tolerated	0	No need for sling / splint	0	No need for crutches / boot

## Pain control:

- o Ice 20 minutes, 3 times per day.
- o Elevate extremity above heart as much as possible.
- o Ibuprofen 800 mg every 8 hours as needed
- Norco 1-2 tablets every 6 hours as needed
